Each week, we have guests who visit our church for the first time. While we have been blessed with a wonderful campus, it can be pretty confusing for guests to make their way around. This is where the CREW Ministry Team come in. We are asking that all members and/or active guests of Saxe Gotha consider serving in some part of this exciting ministry.

How can I serve on CREW?

The Street CREW (Serves rain or shine, hot or cold!)

Responsibilities:

- Waving to and greeting each person or family as they arrive for worship.
- Assisting guests, once parked, with directions to their destinations.
- Inviting guests to the Welcome Center.

(Street CREW will be provided with neon traffic safety vests to ensure you will be noticed and large CREW golf umbrellas for rainy weather (if needed) at the Welcome Center on the Sunday you serve.)

The Food CREW

Responsibilities:

- Care for the CREW serving by providing breakfast (casseroles, doughnuts, coffee & juice on your scheduled Sunday).
- Help keep CREW on schedule by being our timekeepers.
- Drive fellowship with the rest of the CREW during break times.

(Whether you fancy yourself a gourmet cook, enjoy the smell of doughnuts at Krispy Kreme, or have ever been handy with a stop-watch, clipboard and whistle, Food CREW is for YOU!)

The Welcome CREW

Responsibilities

- Greet guests as they enter and answer questions.
- Give directions or even escort guests to their destinations.
- Staff the Welcome Center in the Fellowship Hall, and the Info Centers in Narthex and Atrium.

(If you enjoy being a part of any Welcome Wagon, you never meet a stranger, and have a great inner compass, you'll fit right in with Welcome CREW!)

Frequently Asked Questions

- **How often will I serve?** Once every six weeks your team will gather in the Welcome Center for fellowship, food, devotions and then go serve in your assigned roles.
- Why serve just once every six weeks? We want you to be growing through worship and study each week but are lifting this up as a church-wide opportunity to serve together. If you would like to serve more frequently, you may, but please do not neglect your personal worship and growth.
- Can youth serve? Absolutely! We'd love for all high school aged youth to be a part of this ministry.
- Will you train me in my assigned role? Yes! Whatever team you decide to serve on, we will ensure that you are trained by a member of that specific team.
- Do I have to serve from 7:30 a.m.—12:30 p.m.? We are approaching this as a team, and as such, you will be serving with people from all three services who volunteer, thus helping strengthen community at SGPC. It will also allow us, during the course of the morning, to make sure all positions are filled. However, please feel free to serve as a CREW member at the 8:30 a.m. service or the 11:00 a.m. service (see schedule on back).
- **Can I still worship?** You will have time, if you choose, to hear the message. However, we kindly ask that you return to your assigned position after the service.
- How many people do you need each week for CREW? Glad you asked. We need a team of 15 to serve each week to cover all entrances and accompany guests to their destinations.

Could my spouse and I serve together? Absolutely!!

What about child care? We ask that you do not leave your children in care or programming from 7:30 am – 12:30 pm. Prayerfully consider how you can serve and still best meet the needs of your family.

9:15-9:45 a.m.
